## Handy checklist of tasks to get ready for fall!

- Get your Sun Devil ID card
- Finalize class schedule and find your classes
- Submit your MMR immunization documentation
- Complete your SEVIS check-in
- Check My ASU to ensure you have completed all required tasks
- Open a U.S. bank account
- Set-up cell phone service
- Secure an on-campus parking permit and/or coordinate transportation (purchase a car/bike, get an Arizona drivers' license and insurance)
- Buy and/or rent your course textbooks
- Pay your tuition and fees
- If applicable, move-in and set-up your on-campus housing
- If applicable, search for and sign a lease for off-campus housing
- If applicable, set-up your off-campus housing (move-in, secure utilities, etc...)
