Submit your MMR immunization verification form.

All students born after Jan. 1, 1957, are required to meet certain MMR immunization requirements before classes begin. You can upload the required documentation in the ASU My Health Portal at eoss.asu.edu/health/portal. The MMR vaccine is available for a fee at any ASU Health Services location.

Organize your finances

- Use the budget worksheet.**
Creating an annual budget is an important part of your ASU experience – it helps you understand your total costs, see how your financial aid helps cover those costs, and anticipate a possible remaining balance due to ASU after your aid is applied.

- Complete your FAFSA.**
The Free Application for Federal Student Aid, or FAFSA, is an application you fill out annually to determine how much federal financial aid you're eligible for. **The 2026–2027 application is available beginning in fall 2025.**

- Apply for scholarships.**
There are lots of scholarships out there, including opportunities based on academic achievement, talent, personal stories, creativity and more. Explore hundreds of available scholarships on ASU's Scholarship Universe. Students can build their profile and search and apply for scholarships online.

- Explore student employment.**
ASU offers thousands of well-paying, flexible student job opportunities on campus. Obtain skills that will complement your academic performance. **Teaching and research assistantships** are common forms of professional development and financial support for graduate students at ASU.

- Monitor your financial aid on My ASU.**
Once you've submitted your FAFSA, allow three to five days for ASU to receive it. Then, you can track the status of your financial aid on the Finances tab on My ASU. If you are selected for financial aid verification, you will receive an email from ASU instructing you to check your Priority Tasks for a list of requested items.

Paying for your education

You may be able to get funding assistance for your advanced degree through various financial aid options. Financial aid can cover some or all of your expenses, but you have to know the various types of aid out there and how to apply for them.

Types of financial aid

Fellowships and scholarships

You can apply for aid that does not need to be repaid through fellowships, grants and scholarships. These can come from ASU or outside sources.

Employment

Teaching and research assistantships are valuable ways to earn both experience and money within your academic unit. There are various types of employment for graduate students to consider.

Loans

You may need to consider taking out a loan. Though loans must be repaid, federal loans typically offer the lowest interest rates.
